

Description

Crest Galv-a-Paint is a liquid metal conditioner used to treat galvanized and zinc coated metals, by hand wiping or immersion applications. Galv-a-Paint reacts chemically with the surface of these metals and allows paint to adhere smoothly and evenly. In addition, once paint has dried, Galv-a-Paint helps prevent it from chipping or peeling. The product is a light blue liquid, free from any sediment with no objectional odor during use and leaves no residual odor. To make uncovered areas easily visible, Galv-a-Paint gives the metal surface a dark tint. This makes sure that the entire surface can be visually inspected for complete coverage. Galv-a-Paint will not change in physical state or suffer loss in effectiveness for a period of one year when storage conditions are maintained between 32°F and 140°F.

Method of Use

Application Methods

- » Immersion
- » Hand Application

Mixing Instructions

Under some climatic conditions (hot or dry), it is better to use Galv-a-Paint diluted with up to 3 parts water. Excess solution can be removed with a squeegee, rag, or sponge. When using full strength solutions, a water rinse is recommended.

Application Instructions

- » **Immersion**
 - » If the parts are extremely dirty and greasy, they may be cleaned in a hot alkaline cleaning solution followed by a hot rinse.
 - » To prepare sheets with Galv-a-Paint, dip them in the cold Galv-a-Paint solution for a few seconds.
 - » Remove from the tank and rinse in fresh running water.
 - » Allow to dry. Paint when dry.
- » **Hand Application**
 - » If the surface is oily or greasy, either wipe with clean dry rag or wash off with a volatile solvent to remove the major portion of oil and grease.
 - » Using rubber gloves, rags, mop or brush, apply the Galv-a-Paint full strength or diluted with up to three parts of water. The surface changes color immediately upon application. Be sure the metal is completely covered with the Galv-a-Paint.
 - » If using at full strength a water rinse is recommended.
 - » Following the application of Galv-a-Paint, the metal should be dried before painting.
- » **Equipment** – All tanks may be constructed of plastic, lead-lined steel or stainless steel materials.
